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PATH PROGRAM

PATH provides services to people with serious mental illness, including those with co-occurring substance use disorders, who are experiencing homelessness or at imminent risk of becoming homeless. Individuals must meet PATH criteria to be eligible for the program.

PATH SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

- Outreach Services
- Case Management including referrals for primary health services, job training, educational services, and relevant housing services.
- Housing Support Services to include assistance with identifying and securing appropriate housing and eviction prevention support.
- **SOAR** to include assistance with applying for SSI/SSDI.
